

# The Champalimaud Foundation invites nominations and applications for the €1,000,000 António Champalimaud Vision Award

The annual António Champalimaud Vision Award will be presented in 2023 under a widened scope. The Award is enlarged to institutions, organizations and groups that have developed **innovations or new technologies with impact on the quality of life of the blind and visually impaired**, and which can be accessed by people in the developing world.

In addition, and as before, the 2023 Award is open to organisations with **outstanding contributions towards the prevention and alleviation of blindness and visual impairment, in developing countries.**

The award is directed to groups actively involved in fighting blindness and visual impairment in the field, or that **have developed innovations or new technologies for the blind and visually impaired with direct impact in developing countries**, and is based on the candidate's accomplishments.

Candidates will be considered by a distinguished international jury for the quality and distinction of their work; their achievements and the measurable impact of their pursuit; as well as the enduring amplifying effects of their activities.

The award may be used in any way that furthers the outstanding contributions of the recipients.

**The deadline for submissions is January 15<sup>th</sup> 2023.**
